GROUP ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Ulster™ Carpets recognise that its activities impact on the environment. In this respect, we will ensure that continual environmental performance improvements are achieved by compliance with all requirements of the Environmental Management System ISO 14001.

Therefore, we will:

1. Protect the Biosphere by reducing and where possible eliminating, the release of any substances that may cause environmental damage to the air, water or land. We will endeavour to safeguard all habitats directly or indirectly affected by our operations.

7. Establish, maintain and review environmental objectives and targets for continual performance improvement & energy reduction through a Management programme.
